Thank you for considering this course. We hope this page will answer your questions about the booking process and what you can expect when you attend.

This course is open to everyone. You do not need to have studied Aura-Soma or Kabbalah to attend. Just bring yourself.

Accommodation

We are delighted to have reserved the Chalice Well accommodation from 27 May to 1st June. This accommodation is normally available only to Companions of Chalice Well. All students staying at Chalice Well will have free access to: the gardens at all times (including after hours), the library, the unique meditation room, and, as much Chalice Well water to drink as you wish!

Shared rooms

Please note all accommodation will be shared – two to each room. It keeps down the price of the course and also it gives the rare opportunity to stay at Chalice Well to as many people as possible. You can see the rooms at <http://www.chalicewell.org.uk/> and let us know if you have a room preference. Please understand we cannot guarantee your choice. Rooms will be allocated once full payment has been received on a “*first come - first served*” basis.

Single rooms

If you do not wish to share a room there may be a few limited places on the course for those staying outside of Chalice Well. However these places will **only** become available **once** the **Chalice Well** accommodation is **filled**. Contact us if you would like to add your name to this list; we will allocate places from this list on a “*first come - first served*” basis too.

Arrival and Departure

Please **arrive** at Chalice Well between 17.00 and 19.00 on 27th May (the **day before** the course starts).

Note **check out** is on the **morning of the 1st June** – that is **the last day** of the course. Rooms must be empty by 10am. You can store luggage in a special room during the last day. We can be in the teaching room till 17.00 on the 1st June which is the time the course will finish.

Extra night

If you wish to stay in Glastonbury on the night of the 1st June you will need to arrange your own accommodation. Do let us know of your intention though, we have possibilities to help you find a good place.

Food

Breakfast, lunch and tea break refreshments are included in the course price.

Evening meals are NOT included – but we can cook together in Chalice Well kitchen or, we can go out, together, or separately, as we wish. (Eating in will cost about £5+ each, eating out about £15)

If you have any special dietary needs you will need to bring your own items. There is a kitchen and fridge available. We are not able to cater to individual needs.

Please note Chalice Well operates a strict vegetarian policy.

Reserving and confirming your place

A place on the course can only be **reserved** by paying the £150 deposit. This is non – refundable.

Your place on the course will only be **confirmed** when you have paid the full amount.

Note room choices cannot be reserved with a deposit, they will only be allocated when the full amount has been paid.

Prices and Payment

The course price includes 5 days of teaching, (shared) accommodation in Chalice Well for 5 nights: 27 – 31 May 2012, and breakfast, lunch, and tea break refreshments (but **not** dinners).

There are three levels of price depending on when final payment is made:
if before

1st May 2012 is the final due date for payment. We will not be accepting cash payments on arrival at course. Places not paid for in full by 1st May 2012 may be offered to waiting students.

Please note International bank transfers incur a £6 bank surcharge – please add £6 to any payment you make to cover this cost.

For **credit card payments** we use **PayPal**. PayPal add a 3.4% processing fee to any payment. We will add this amount to any payment request we send you. Payment requests are made by email and are easy to respond to.

You can pay by **cheque** – it will need to be made in GBP. There is a small surcharge to add in the case of international cheques to cover the bank fee.

Travel details

You will need to make your own travel arrangements

Airplane

Bristol Airport is the closest (but can be expensive to fly to)
Taxi is about £50 one way. Could be shared by up to 3 people. We can help you coordinate to share the cost if you wish.

London Heathrow is next closest airport.

There is a National Express bus to Glastonbury (£20 about) but late departure 19.00 and arrival 23.00.

A taxi is about £200. Again we can help co-ordinate sharing if you wish.

Train

Nearest station is Castle Cary

1hour 45 minutes from London Paddington about £75 return.

London Paddington has a direct connection to London Heathrow.

Heathrow Express. 15 minute journey, £32 return.

Taxi from Castle Cary (9 miles) about £15
